The nine-member committee to examine different aspects of constructing a capital city

The Andhra Pradesh government wants to build the new capital as a vibrant, inclusive city that uses natural resources efficiently, promotes green spaces, smart development and provides productive, comfortable and happy life for its residents.

On Sunday, the State government issued a GO constituting a nine-member advisory committee with Municipal Administration Minister P. Narayana as its chairman to examine different aspects of constructing a capital city as well as suggest an action plan for its development. The committee has four industrialists.

The other members of the committee are: Y.S. Chowdary (Rajya Sabha member), G. Jayadev (Lok Sabha member, Guntur), former MLA Beeda Masthan Rao, G.V. Sanjay Reddy of GVK Group, Bommidala Srinivas of GMR Group, **M. Prabhakara Rao, chairman, Nuziveedu Seeds Ltd.**, Chintalapati Srinivasa Raju, chairman, Peepul Capital and Principal Secretary to Government, (MA&UD) as member convenor.

In addition to these members, three prominent persons of national and international repute may be co-opted as special invitees to the committee. According to the GO, the committee shall advise the government on the following:

Conceptualisation of a vibrant, diverse and inclusive city which is a magnet for skilled workforce; creation of a highly livable urban eco-system that provides a productive, comfortable and a happy life for all its residents; efficient use of natural resources – land, water and energy – minimal commutes, green technologies, green spaces, water-fronts etc., that promotes smart and sustainable urban development; Urban Planning policies that promote vertical development along transportation corridors and effective institutional and management systems for cost-efficient construction and professional management of the new capital.
